

Ceramics rental and pricing

Adult students **must be members** of the GoggleWorks, to access open studio hours.

- The monthly rate is \$95.00.
- The day rate is \$20.00.

Included in the rate are basic firing (bisque and glaze up to Cone 6) costs for 25 pounds of clay per month. All clay must be purchased. To purchase clay, go to Front Desk and pay. Upon return to studio with a paid receipt, a staff member will get your clay.

Goggleworks will only fire clay that is purchased at or through the GoggleWorks.

Additional materials are available for purchase at the GoggleWorks shop. These materials are: private reclaim buckets and all tools beyond the studio basics.

Renters must keep all work, and clay, tools, and materials on designated shelf only. Please see Work Flow for details. All work must be picked up within 1 month of any class session, field trip, or rental period, unless special arrangements have been made. Please understand that GW does not have space to store your work. After 1 month, work AT ANY STAGE left behind will be moved to unclaimed area and will be used or recycled.

GoggleWorks reserves the right to charge additional fees in the case of kiln accidents or other damage that is due to carelessness or negligence on the part of students and renters during the glazing or firing process. It is extremely important to sponge off the bottom of your work after the final coat of glaze, and leave at least a quarter inch of room between the glaze line and the foot. Also, it is the renter's responsibility to identify the recommended firing range of purchased clay on bottom of each piece. Equipment damage due to renter's negligence will result in renter paying for the cost of repair.

All users of the ceramics studio, no matter what prior level of experience, must participate in a basic orientation (15-30 minutes) with staff before beginning to work in the studio. Please schedule this with our manager.

When you are ready to bisque or glaze fire, show GW staff your work, or label clearly and leave in kiln room. GW will track your kiln use on a log and give you a bill to take to the front desk and pay once you fire more than the monthly 25 lbs., or if you are renting a kiln. All kiln rental will be supervised by GW staff. Special rules apply to all gas kiln firings. We will fire only clay obtained through Goggleworks. GW reserves the right to charge fees for damage due to neglect or carelessness.

FIRING SCHEDULE OPERATES AS FOLLOWS:

Generally speaking, we fire bisque, Cone 04 glazes, and Cone 6 glazes as soon as a kiln load appears in designated area. Special firings such as Raku, Cone 10, and Gas Kiln will be posted on calendar near kiln.

- Please familiarize yourself with which carts and shelves are for ware to be bisqued, and which carts and shelves are for ware to be glazed. These will be labeled appropriately.

Private Lessons:

Costs:

- \$75.00 for one student. Includes one and a half hour instruction. Materials cost not included.
- \$95.00 for two students. Includes one and a half hour instruction. Materials cost not included.
- \$125.00 for three students. Includes two hours of instruction. Materials cost not included.
- Group parties cost is determined by Program Director.

GoggleWorks Special Material Purchases Through Ceramics Studio:

A wide selection of clay, glazes and tools can be ordered through the GoggleWorks. In order to make a purchase, select the tools or materials that you desire and fill out a purchase order form with your instructor and/or studio staff. Then take the paperwork with to the main reception desk to pay for the materials. Return to studio with the paid invoice. You will receive your materials once they arrive.
