



GOGGLEWORKS POLICY
FOR SERVING ALCOHOL AT NON-GOGGLEWORKS SPONSORED EVENTS

Alcoholic beverages may not be served at personal or other events which are not directly related to GoggleWorks business unless bartending service is provided by a bartender approved by the GoggleWorks. Bartender is responsible for verifying proper age identification. A licensed bartender must be used if hard alcohol is being served. This service may be arranged through the GoggleWorks Staff Office or may be provided through your caterer.

It is the responsibility of the group renting the GoggleWorks facility to purchase all alcoholic beverages and to secure a liquor license for the event if admission is being charged.

The "Lessee" will indemnify, defend (including attorney's fees and costs), and hold harmless GoggleWorks from and against any claim for personal injury or property damage arising out of "Lessee's use of GoggleWorks facilities.

GoggleWorks requires all rental groups serving alcohol to supply a Certificate of Insurance specifying the GoggleWorks as an "Additional Named Insured." The policy must show the organization is insured for a minimum of \$1,000,000 (one million) bodily injury and property damage combined liability limit per occurrence during the time the events are to take place at the GoggleWorks. The certificate must clearly show that the coverage period includes all set up and take down times as well as the time of the event.

Alcohol service must end one hour prior to the event's end time.
